

Instructions for 2008 Boys High School Roster & Checklist Form

Please reference USA Rugby General and Event Specific Eligibility Guidelines when filling out this form. These guidelines can be found on the www.USARugby.org website under “Membership” – “Eligibility” – “Eligibility Regulations” You must be in complete understanding of all regulations and how they apply to the competition as well as your team before you can fill out this form.

This form applies to Boys High School Championships

TO FILL OUT FORM:

1. Type or clearly print player’s names alphabetically by last name. For this event you may have an unlimited number of people on your roster. If you have more than 30 people on your roster please start a new form and renumber starting at 31.
2. Fill in each player’s current CIPP Registration number, and ensure that it is current (paid in full for the 2008 season) and that it is affiliated with your club. CIPP Information can be located on the USA Rugby Membership website. (<https://register.usarugby.org/rugby/DesktopDefault.aspx>)
3. Players are eligible if they have not reached their 19th birthday by September 1st of the current competitive year.
4. Players must be enrolled in high school and attending classes full time, as defined by the High School Registrar.
5. Players must be within four (4) years of the moment the player first enrolled in ninth grade, regardless of when that player started playing rugby or had the ability to start playing rugby.
6. Fill in the current contact info for your team, so that you can be contacted for follow up information, emergency or any last minute changes for the event.
7. Fill in your Club CIPP number and ensure that it is current (paid in full for the 2008 season) and that your club is in Good Standing with your LAU, TU and USA Rugby.
8. Review and verify that all the information you have collected is correct and up to date. Sign and date. By signing you are taking responsibility for the information on the page. If that information is found to be inaccurate, forged or incorrect there will be disciplinary sanctions placed on you as team representative, the player found in violation and the Territory Official who signed the document. Disciplinary sanctions may include fines, suspension or loss of seeds for future competitions.
9. Pass along to your Territorial Representative. This should be your TU President or some other elected official. This person will need to verify this information is correct, by signing and dating the document. By signing they are taking responsibility for the information on the page. If that information is found to be inaccurate, forged or incorrect there will be disciplinary sanctions placed on you as team representative, the player and the Territory Official who signed the document. Disciplinary sanctions may include fines, suspension or loss of seeds for future competitions.

THIS FORM MUST BE RECEIVED IN THE NATIONAL OFFICE AT LEAST FIVE (5) BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO THE CHAMPIONSHIP EVENT.
